Byron Heritage Festival Fishing Derby Rules and Regulations (Contact Bob Alcott @ 813-1623)

These Guidelines are subject to change at any time by the Heritage Festival Committee

- 1.) Catch and release derby open to anyone.
- 2.) All fish caught by hook and line. No spearing or netting will be allowed. Any form of bait or tackle is permitted, but will not be provided.
- 3.) Derby will begin promptly at 8 a.m. and conclude at 10 a.m. on the morning of July 25, 2009. Early registration will begin at 7:30 a.m. on that day.
- 4.) You must fish only from the bank of Trestle Park Pond.
- 5.) Please respect others space and the outdoors. All park rules must be obeyed.
- 6.) All species of fish will be accepted. Catches must be witnessed or weighed and measured by one of the derby officials and then properly released. A card will be provided to you upon registration which your catches will be recorded on by an official.
- 7.) Judging criteria are as follows: most fish caught, longest fish caught and heaviest fish caught.

We look forward to seeing you at Trestle Park for a fun fishing event rain or shine.

These Guidelines are subject to change at any time by the Heritage Festival Committee

1. This contest is open to all ages.
2. Each team shall consist of two (2) players.
3. Each game will begin with the flip of a coin. The winner of the flip will have choice of first or second pitch.
4. Tournament will be double elimination.
5. Best two out of three games will be played. Each game will consist of 21 points. Value of the shoe is as follows: Ringer =3 points, Leaner or within shoe length=1 point.
6. Each player can only participate on one team.
