# STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Byron, effective at 12:00 a.m. on March 28, 2020.


This State of Emergency has been declared due to the existing and continuing declared States of Emergencies by the Federal, New York State and Genesee County governments related to the Covid-19 Virus.

This situation threatens public safety.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect for thirty (30) days or until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As the Chief Executive of the Town of Byron, County of Genesee, State of New York, I, Peter N. Yasses, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of this Municipality.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Town of Byron to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and to provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
