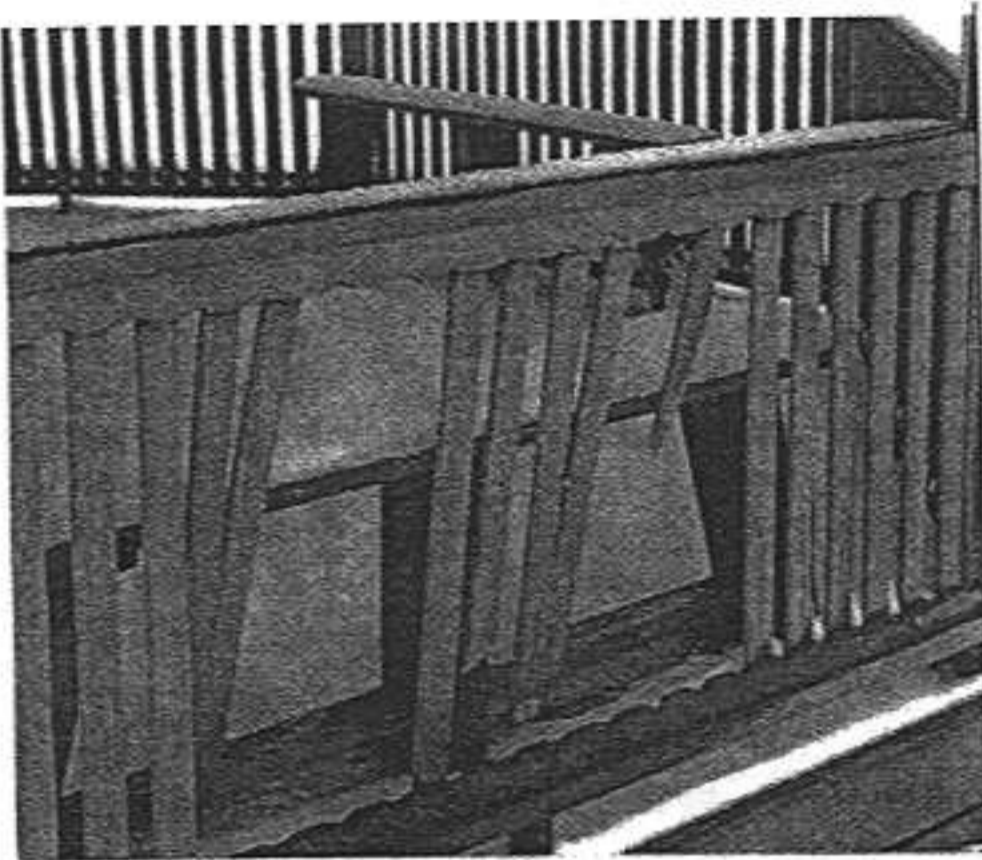

**WE NEED YOUR HELP !!**

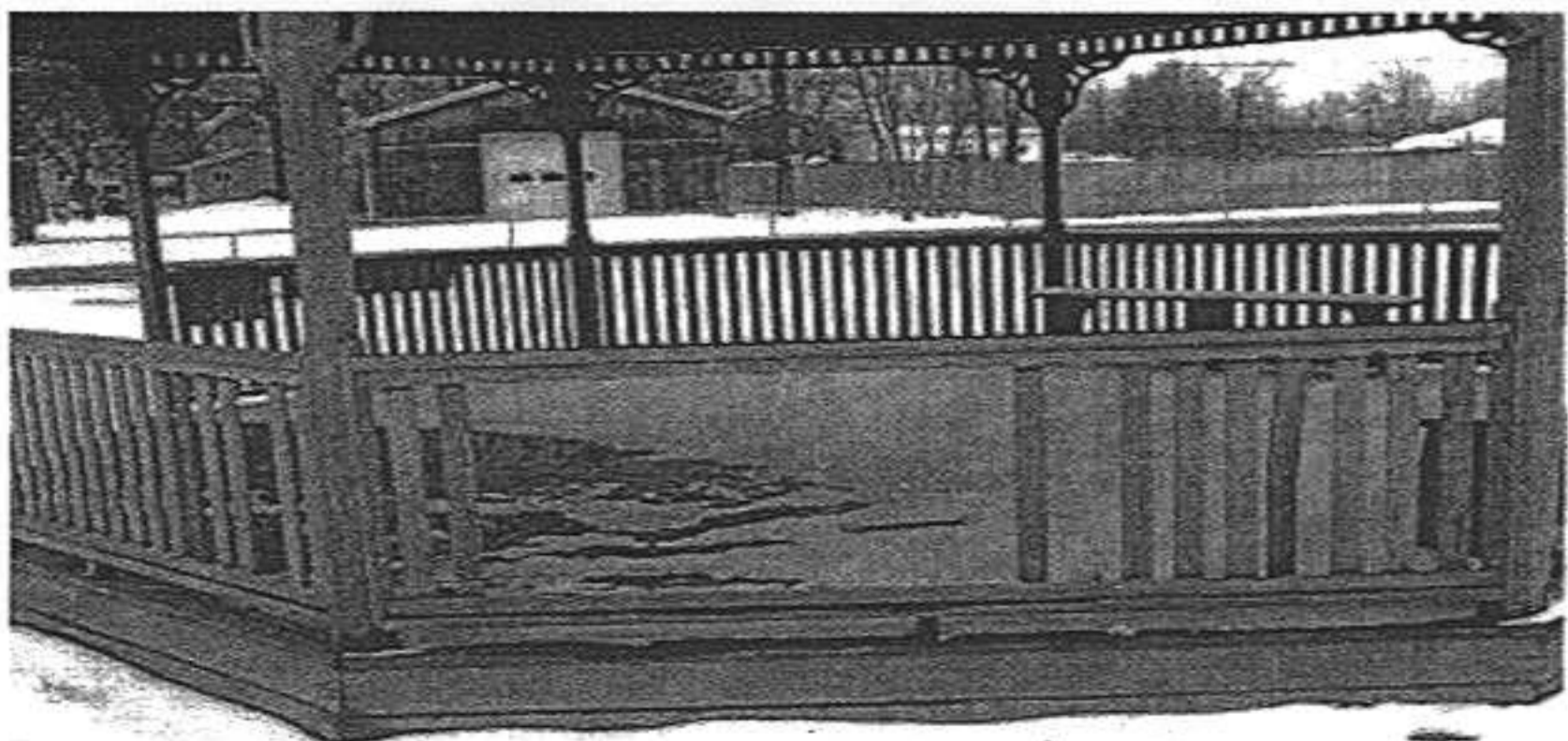


The Byron Park Committee is asking for your help in solving the problems of vandalism. Many times over there has been damage done to the beautiful gazebo at the McElver Street Community Park.

3. \$10.00 / Turtle Park Pavilion

## WESTSHORE TRAIL STUDY

Last fall the Genesee County Planning Dept. met with representatives from the Towns of Byron and Bergen, to ask if the towns would be interested in obtaining grants, to develop the old Westshore Railroad Bed into a Regional Trail System.

Both towns indicated that they were interested and would like to explore the possibilities of this project.

Two weeks ago our representatives met with the Genesee Transportation Council out of Rochester. They indicated to us that the towns could apply for a grant to do a Feasibility Study. This study would be funded by 80% in grant money and 20% by the shared municipality. The 20% could be a cost of approximately \$2,000 to \$2,500 per town.
