What is Community Solar?

Community solar allows renters and homeowners to benefit from a local solar farm without the cost or installation of panels. By subscribing to a share of the farm's energy, you support clean power and receive credits on your electricity bill for the solar power generated, saving you money each month.



Energy Credits

Are generated at the solar farm and delivered to your electric utility provider.



Your Bill

Your utility applies the solar credits on your bill, reducing what you owe.

You pay 10% less for the solar credits you receive, saving you money every month.

DID YOU KNOW?

New York State legislators launched community solar in 2015 as part of the Shared Renewables Program, helping to make clean, locally-generated energy accessible to New York residents.

Our average community solar subscriber prevents the equivalent of 8 hot air balloons of CO2 from entering our atmosphere every year.







- Have your National Grid account number handy. We use that to notify your utility that you'll be a community solar subscriber.
- Enter your information online and review the subscription agreement for the Community Solar farm.
 - That's it! We'll look at your past electricity usage to allocate you the right amount of solar energy, and your utility company will apply the credits to your bill every month.
